



UNSHAKEABLE.

Hebrews 12:26-28

²⁶ At that time his voice shook the earth, but now he has promised, “Once more I will shake not only the earth but also the heavens.” ²⁷ The words “once more” indicate the removing of what can be shaken—that is, created things—so that what cannot be shaken may remain.

²⁸ Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken, let us be thankful, and so worship God acceptably with reverence and awe, ²⁹ for our “God is a consuming fire.”

PSALMS 27

1. I will live strong.

Psalms 27:1-3

2. I will love God's house passionately.

Psalms 27:4-5

I will love God's house with a faithful and fervent spirit and a heart of unwavering devotion, service and zeal.

3. I will hold my head high.

Psalms 27:6

I will boldly declare the greatness of God and the power of His word. I will not live in defeat, but will stand my ground and fearlessly praise my God. I know God will lift me up and I will live life with my head held high.

4. I will pursue a life of holiness.

Psalms 27:11-12

I will choose a lifestyle of integrity and I will walk according to the principles of God's word. I will learn God's ways and walk on a level path.

5. I will not lose heart.

Psalms 27:13-14

I will resist the lies of the enemy that seek to blind my eyes to the goodness and greatness of God working in my life. My God is for me and is able to strengthen my heart at all times so I refuse to lose heart.
